**GOVERNMENT DISBURSES KSH. 3.52 BILLION FOR FEBRUARY 2025  
INUA JAMII PROGRAMME**

---

The Ministry of Labour and Social Protection, through the State Department for Social Protection and Senior Citizen Affairs has released **Ksh. Three Billion, Five Hundred and Twenty-Three Million, Seven Hundred and Ninety Four thousand (3,523,794,000)** for payment to **1,761,897 beneficiaries** enrolled in the Inua Jamii Program.

Payment commenced on Monday, 10<sup>th</sup> March, 2025, with each beneficiary set to receive Ksh. 2,000 covering the February 2025 cycle.

Beneficiaries of the Inua Jamii Programme, including older persons aged 70 and above, caregivers of orphans and vulnerable children, and caregivers of persons with severe disabilities, can access their funds by dialing \*222# and withdraw funds by visiting the nearest M-PESA Agent.

Inua Jamii beneficiaries who still do not have registered phone numbers are advised to visit any Safaricom or MPESA Agent countrywide to register a line that will enable them access their stipend.

The Inua Jamii Cash Transfer Programme remains a cornerstone of the government's social protection strategy. It aims to alleviate poverty and promote the well-being of society's most vulnerable members, including older persons aged 70 and above, orphans and vulnerable children, and persons living with severe disability.
